Can't Stop Cormier



Lukas Cormier had three assists on Saturday, his third three-point performance of the season. Cormier has points in 11 of his last 12 games, totaling two goals and 14 points over that stretch. With 34 points in 35 games, Cormier is one point shy of his career high, set

in 2022-23 when he posted 35 points in 62 games. Cormier is tied with Coachella Valley's Tyson Jugnauth for fourth among all AHL defensemen in scoring. He is two points shy of 100 for his AHL career.
