SHAVE/SCRAPE



TIPS

Due to the intricacy of the pattern, we recommend that you enlarge the pattern on a copier to fit your pumpkin.

- 1. Save the pattern to refer to it while carving.
- 2. Hollow out and slightly thin your pumkins shell.
- 3. Trace the design by using a pin to prick small holes through the paper into the pumpkin (following the lines).
- 4. Shave/scrape away just enough of the outside of the horsehoe so the light will glow through.
- 5. Carefully carve away the rest of the horseshoe. Be sure to keep your saw blade at a 90° angle.
